

# TRINITY SUNDAY

(Proverbs 8.22-31, Romans 5.1-5, John 16.12-15)

**Theme: In Oneness We Shall Succeed**

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity. The three persons in one God, united in love. This celebration of the most Holy Trinity reminds us that we have only one God.

He is our Father, our Creator, our Provider and our Salvation. God created us out of his love; saves us by his love and wants us to live and abide in his love. For God is love Himself.

It is this pure love that united God the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit eternally together. And it is the divine will of God our Father, that we be united in His love. We can be united in God's love only if we are one with Him, and one in love with others.
